

## Virtual Training Session on Comprehensive Port Package Policies and Oil and Energy Insurance (CVT- PPP & O&E) 7<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> October 2021



The risk associated with the entry and exit points for the cargo carried; and the importance of providing insurance protection to Ports and Terminals, is often not properly understood and appreciated. Port authorities and terminal operators face a combination of operational, commercial and environmental risks. The risks involved include the ships coming into or leaving the berth, the trucks and containers arriving to and departing from the Port, the huge amount of costly specialized equipment and machinery on the quayside, liabilities to employees of the port, ships and other stake-holders as well as visitors and other third parties.

The oil and gas industry is a diverse setting encompassing multiple industries, both onshore and offshore, upstream, downstream, pipeline, and more. These operations are all part of the same industry, but each specific business has its own set of risks and potential dangers to avoid. Property could be destroyed, natural disasters could occur, serious mechanical failure could cause environmental damage.
