

FAQ on Surveyor Training- Fresh and Additional Departments

1. Who will be eligible for surveyor Fresher Training?

The candidate will be eligible for the Fresher Surveyor Training Program if they have enrolled for the surveyor examination of Insurance Institute of India (III) on and after 01st April 2021 & qualified the same. He must have passed the compulsory subject S.01 and relevant subject for which License is sought. After passing the exam applicant has to undergo 8 weeks of Institutional practical training program.

2. Who will be eligible for surveyor Additional department Training?

Those existing surveyors who want to get license in additional departments. They must have passed the exam in the relevant subject after 01st April 2021. A maximum of 3 departments can be opted for. After passing the relevant subject, the applicant has to undergo Institutional practical training for a period of 2 weeks.

3. Who will conduct the Institutional practical training for Fresher's / Additional dept. training?

The Institutional practical training for fresher surveyors is being conducted by III (Insurance Institute of India) and in additional department is being conducted by NIA (National Insurance Academy) **on rotational basis.**

For Fresh Surveyor Training:

- 1) Training period two months (1 month virtual classroom + 1 month onsite training)
- 2) Institutional practical training will be conducted
 - ✓ Jan to June 2022 by National Insurance Academy.
 - ✓ July to December 2022 by Insurance Institute of India.

For Additional Department Training:

- 1) Training period two weeks (1 week virtual training + 1 week onsite training)
- 2) Institutional practical training will be conducted

✓ **Jan to June 2022**

III - Fire Insurance, Marine Cargo, Marine Hull Engineering insurance, Loss & Profit.

NIA - Motor, Miscellaneous Insurance, Crop Insurance.

✓ **July to December 2022 by National Insurance Academy**

NIA - Fire Insurance, Marine Cargo, Marine Hull Engineering Insurance, Loss & Profit.

III - Motor, Miscellaneous Insurance, Crop Insurance.

4. What about Non-institutional training for Fresh and Additional department?

As per IRDAI circular IRDA/SUR/GDL/MISC/068/03/2021 dated 01st April 2021 candidates having necessary qualifications and having passed the examination in relevant subject may undergo “Non-Institutional Practical Training” with surveyors having a minimum of 8 years’ experience.

The duration of training is 6 months for Fresher &

The duration is 8 weeks for training in each additional department.

Insurance Institute of India will conduct an examination after completion of the training (for both Institutional and Non Institutional) and .The candidates have to appear for the final test which will be conducted by either of the Institutes. (III/NAI), depending on the training being conducted by them- Fresher’s or Additional.

5. Information regarding exam date, payment link & final certificate?

III will announce the post training exam date on their portal. The candidate may please check for the same on completion of onsite training.

On successful completion of training and final practical test the III/NIA will issue the Training Evaluation cum Completion Certificate.

6. What will be the Institutional practical training fees?

Training Fees for Fresher : Rs. 50,000/-
Training Fees for Addl. Dept.: Rs. 10,000/-

7. What is required to be submitted for the institutional training?

- a) IRDAI Enrolment number
- b) IIISLA membership number (for Add dept.)
- c) III Exam Mark sheet

8. What about final practical test after Non institutional training?

After completion of the onsite training candidate has to submit trainer completion certificate (form no 16.) with photo. Then they have to approach the institutional (III/NAI) for exam.

Exam fees for Fresher : Rs. 2500/- plus GST
Exam fees for Addl. Dept. : Rs. 1500/- plus GST

9. How will I get the licence?

Following documents will be sent by us to IRDAI for issuance of licence after completion of all above procedures:

- 1) Training completion certificate of onsite training from the trainer
- 2) Training Evaluation cum completion certificate conducted by Insurance Institute of India at the end of 2 weeks/8 weeks.
