The sector is increasingly exposed to NATCAT and manmade events as well as greater accumulation of risk on ships and import. The frequency and severity of cargo claims has been increasing, with a combination of large losses and natural catastrophe activity. There has been an increasing risk of large losses due to increasing value accumulations at ports, warehouses and vessels. Cargo misappropriation is another growing issue. High value cargoes, like oil and iron ore, can be either stolen or illegally sold. It is a global issue, where risks need to be assessed and monitored carefully to avoid losses. The growing use of technology has its downside too in terms of increase in losses due to cyber breaches. The maritime frauds has also been a growing area of concern for the sector.
