India launched its National Solar Mission in 2010 under the National Action Plan on Climate Change, with plans to generate 20 GW by 2022. At the World Future Energy Summit (WFES) held in Abu Dhabi in January 2018, the government of India announced the setting up of a \$350 million solar development fund to enable in the financing of solar projects. Insurance
