Relevance of the Program:-

India is the third ranked country in terms of total number of dams, next after the US and China, and it has 5,334 big dams and another 412 dams under construction. All engineering structures constitute a load on the earth's crust. Heterogeneity of materials of the earth's crust and the complexity of their arrangement is well documented, and these geologic conditions result into most engineering problems. Humongous risks are involved in major constructions like Dams, Bridges, Tunnels and erection of any infrastructure. These projects require risk assessment and management approach to suit the specific needs of project financiers. On construction/ erection sites, external factors like natural hazards or fire risks can exacerbate the risk exposure in addition to the risk posed by the construction/ erection activities.

Recognizing this requirement of the market, the College of Insurance has developed a specific course on engineering project insurance claims to understand how to handle claims of such large projects effectively and efficiently.

- Role of Risk Assessment and Risk Management in large projects at the Proposal Stage
- Types and construction risks of Bridges, Dams, Tunnels, Pipelines
- Best practices to be adopted in the effective handling of Project Claims
