



Virtual Training Session on Comprehensive Port Package Policies (CVT – CPPP) –5th- 6th October, 2020



Transportation by oceans and rivers being most economical and eco-friendly, cargo movement ships becomes increasingly preferred. While the insurance of ships, container vessels and the cargo that they carry are well known, the risk associated with the entry and exit points for the cargo carried; and the importance of providing insurance protection to Ports and Terminals, is often not properly understood and appreciated. Port authorities and terminal operators face a combination of operational, commercial and environmental risks. The risks involved include the ships coming into or leaving the berth, the

trucks and containers arriving to and departing from the Port, the huge amount of costly specialized equipment and machinery on the quayside, liabilities to employees of the port, ships and other stake-holders as well as visitors and other third parties. Some of the larger terminal groups with locations all over the world have property portfolio values which run into billions of dollars. Though risks could be generically similar, as no two operators actually face the same range of risks, the cover must be tailored to individual situations. With the emphasis on Sagar Mala Projects and the beginning of usage of river waterways as means of goods transport, a large number of small ports are coming up in India, leading to a growth in demand for Port Package Policies.

COI has created '**Virtual Training (CVT) Rooms**' as a cost-effective mechanism for participants to equip themselves academically at their respective locations.

Programme Deliverables: This two day workshop aims to sensitize stakeholders about the various risks faced by large and small ports, ways to handle them, design suitable policies for them and learn how to underwrite those risks. The programme is designed to enable participants to:

- ◆ To understand the operational, commercial and environmental risks faced at Port by various stakeholders
- ◆ To gain an insight into various Additional Covers/Wordings required for adequate coverage
- ◆ To know which are the most appropriate extensions and clauses required
- ◆ How to design a tailor made policy
- ◆ How to handle the multiple claims that arise on a port under a single policy.
